## FACTORS AFFECTING THE LEVEL OF PROJECT EFFORT

### If STI **DOES** meet the criteria to the right:

### If STI **DOES NOT** meet the criteria to the right:

Use the chart below as a guide **but** be aware that the level of effort is subject to change.

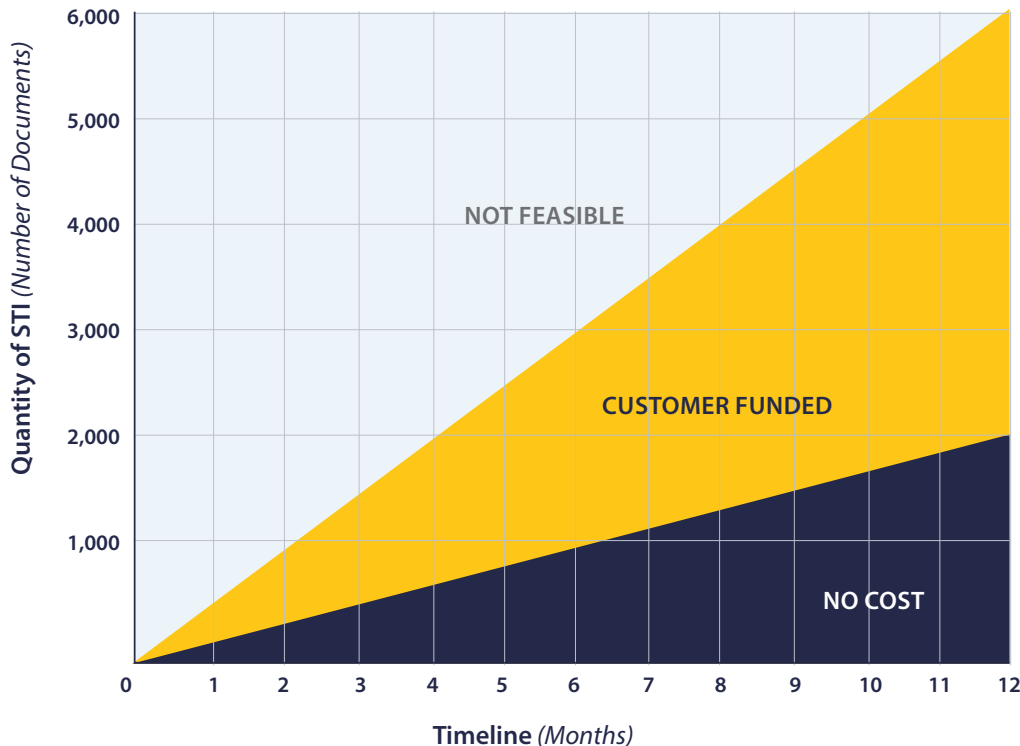
✓ **Digital?** Physical documents will require additional effort to digitize.

✓ **PDF?** Documents that are not in a PDF file format will need to be converted to PDF and ensured text is searchable.

✓ **Proper distribution and classification markings?** Documents without distribution or classification markings or with inconsistent or inaccurate markings will require additional coordination and effort.

✓ **Clear document metadata?** Documents with unclear metadata, such as title, author, date, controlling organization, etc., will require additional effort.

✓ **Unclassified?** We can collect and process both unclassified and classified, but handling and processing classified documents increases the complexity and level of effort.



### NOT FEASIBLE:

It is not feasible to process this number of STI given the timeline.

### NO COST:

There is no cost for us to process this number of STI given the timeline.

### CUSTOMER FUNDED:

Efforts to process this number of STI given the timeline will require customer-funded task orders.
